## PREPARING FOR THE NEW ROMAN MISSAL

### A Summer Institute for Priests

With the imminent confirmation of the first new English-language translation of the *Roman Missal* in almost 40 years, priests and pastoral staffs are faced with an enormous challenge and an incredible opportunity. This two-day workshop for priests is designed to provide an understanding of the origins of the third edition of the *Missale Romanum* and the translation principles and process followed for its completion. We will explore opportunities provided by the new translations for a deepening of pastoral and priestly spirituality as well as practical strategies for their implementation.

#### Presenters:

**Monsignor James P. Moroney** is a faculty member of Saint John's Seminary and serves as Executive Secretary to the *Vox Clara* Commission. A consultant to the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, Monsignor Moroney is a Priest of the Diocese of Worcester and Rector of Saint Paul's Cathedral.

**Reverend Dennis McManus** is an advisor to the *Vox Clara* Commission. A Priest of the Diocese of Mobile, he serves as theological advisor to the Archbishop of New York.

**Reverend Jonathan Gaspar** is a priest of the Boston Archdiocese. He serves as a Priest-Secretary to Cardinal Seán O'Malley of Boston, as well as Co-Director of the Archdiocesan Office of Worship and Spiritual Life.
